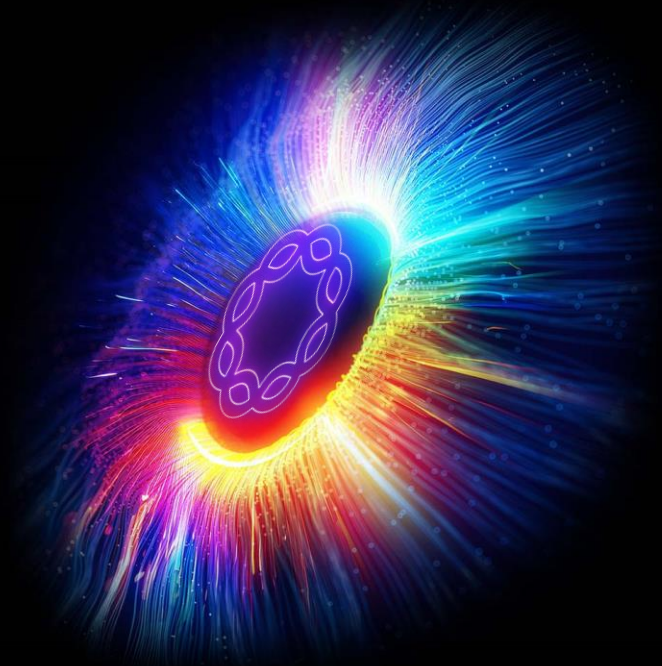

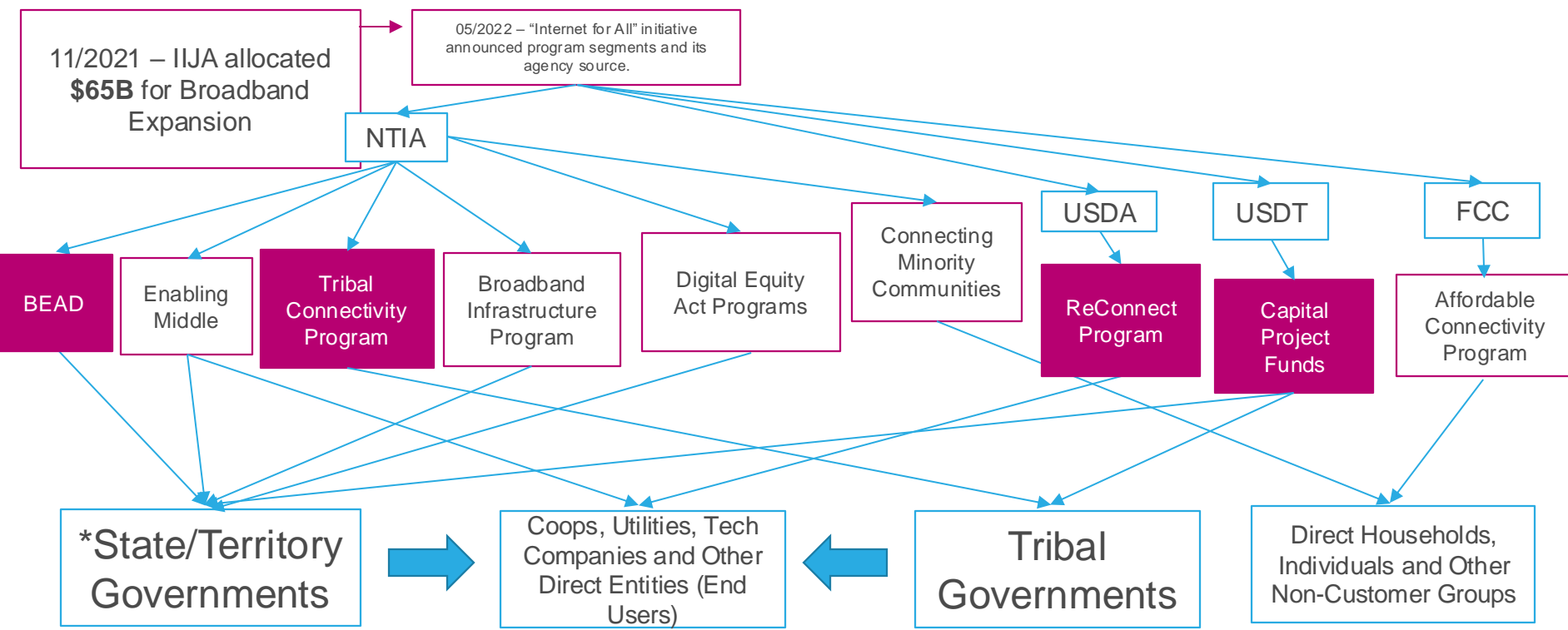

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# Background Broadband Grant Programs



\*The funding allocated to states are allocated to the programs created by their broadband divisions (ex. LA GUMBO program, NC GREAT program, etc.)

# Status of Current Government Funding Programs

## Eligible Entities:

- Corporations
- LLC/Ps
- Coops
- State, local and territory governments
- Federally recognized Tribes



## Milestones:

- Round 1 – \$600M
- Round 2 - \$550M
- Round 3 - \$1B
- Round 4 - \$750M
- Round 5 - \$667M

## Types of Assistance:

- 100% Grant
- 100% Loan
- 50% Loan / 50% Grant

## Usage of Funds:

- Improvements
- Construction
- Acquisitions
- Preapplication expenses

# USDA Telecommunications Infrastructure Loans and Loan Guarantees

## Eligible Entities:

- Cooperatives
- Nonprofits
- For-profit companies
- State and local governmental entities
- Federally recognized Tribes

## Types of Assistance:

- Direct Loans
- Loan Guarantees

## Usage of Funds:

- Improvements
- Expansions
- Construction
- Acquisitions
- Refinancing

## Eligibility Requirements:

- Areas with a population of <5,000
- Be able to operate and maintain a telecommunications system, along with the financial feasibility of their projects.



# Capital Projects Fund - \$10B

## Purpose

Aid states, territories, and Tribal governments fund capital projects that enable work, education, and healthcare monitoring in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.



## Implementation

- States received their fund allocation in 2022.
- State programs were created to determine subgrantees. (ex. Texas BOOT Program)

## Focus

- broadband infrastructure
- digital connectivity technology
- critical infrastructure projects

# 5G Fund for Rural America

## Multi-round Reverse Auction

- Phase I - \$8B
- Phase II - \$1B

## Current Status

- As of **August 2024**, the FCC has relaunched the 5G Fund
- **The FCC has yet to announce the start date for the funding auction**

**Eligibility** determined based on broadband coverage data from the FCC's **Digital Opportunity Data Collection** initiative.

- Winning bidders must deploy networks with mobile broadband speeds of **>35/3 Mbps**, with deployment milestones met over a six year period





# Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program

## Program Goals:

- Expand Broadband Infrastructure
- Improve Broadband Service Quality
- Promote Digital Equity

## Usage of Funds

- Infrastructure
- Connecting underserved homes and businesses
- Providing digital literacy programs

## Eligible Entities:

- Tribal Governments
- Tribal Organizations
- Tribal Entities

## Milestones:

- Round 1 – \$1.78B
- Round 2 - \$980M



# Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program (BEAD) - \$42.45B

## Priorities:

1. Unserved (<25/3)
2. Underserved (<100/20)
3. Community Anchor Institutions
4. Non-deployment projects (ex. Adoption)

## Requirements:

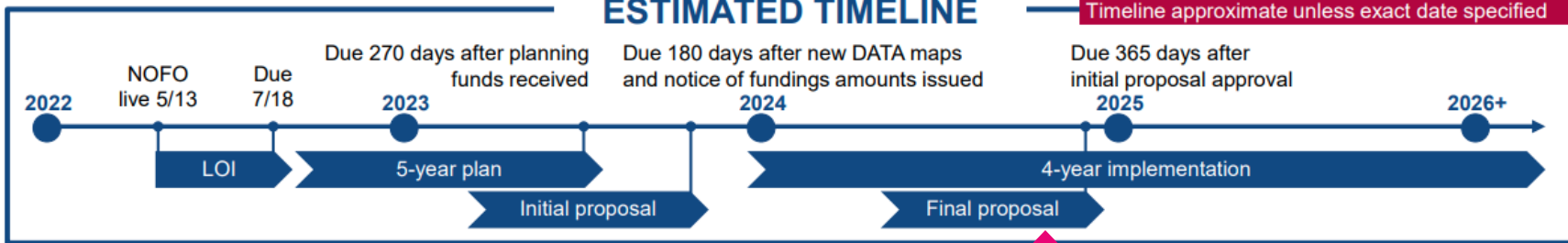
- Provide service of at least 100/20
- Participate in ACP or low-cost program
- Minimum of 25% match

## Example Eligible Uses:

- Planning for deployment of internet
- Deploying or upgrading internet
- Installing Internet in multi-tenant buildings
- Implementing adoption and digital equity programs
- Workforce and job training

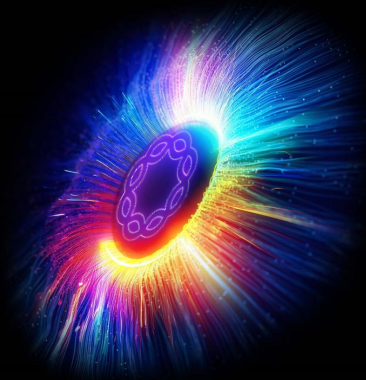
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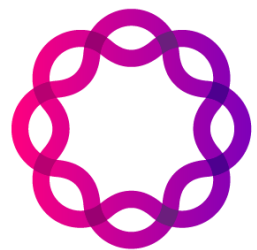
